How is the course structured

Coursework = 60% of your A Level

Exam (Practical) = 40% of your A Level

You will produce 2 projects for your coursework and 1 project for your exam.

Each component is broken down into 4 assessment objectives.



What will/can I study?

Candidates are required to work in at least **two** of the following areas of Art and Design for component 1 and **one** area for component 2. They may explore **overlapping areas and combinations of areas.**

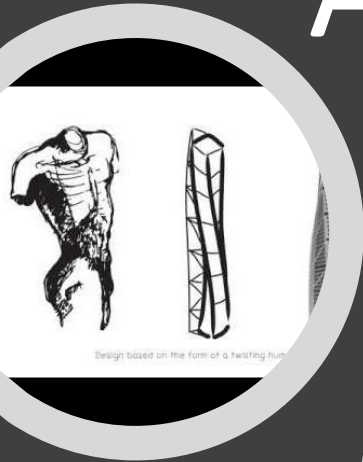
