### Y11 'An Inspector Calls' Theatre visit – Thursday 16 April 2020

The English Department at King Egbert School are pleased to inform you that we have secured enough tickets for all of Y11 to go and see a live performance of 'An Inspector Calls' on Thursday 16 April at 7.45pm.

As one of the set texts that the students will answer questions on in their GCSE Literature exam, this highly acclaimed production will provide valuable insight into text and provide engaging revision for the students in the preparation for their May exam.

This production of 'An Inspector Calls' is Stephen Daldry's multi award-winning production for the National Theatre and returns after a sell-out London season and American tour.

Daldry's visionary, radical, challenging version of JB Priestley's classic thriller, hailed as the theatrical event of its generation, has been seen by more than 4 million people worldwide.

The performance will be on Thursday 16 April 2020 and begins at 7.45pm and we ask that students meet teaching staff outside the theatre at 7.00pm prompt. Parents/carers must arrange to meet their child after the performance or give permission for them to make their own way home.

In order for the theatre trip to proceed we are asking parents/carers to make a voluntary contribution of **£12.25** per child to cover theatre tickets. If we do not receive sufficient contributions then the trip may not go ahead. However, we do not want the cost to prevent those experiencing financial hardship from taking part.

If your child has free school meals no contribution is expected. If you are not in receipt of free school meals but think you may need financial support or more time to pay for the trip, please contact your child's Year Manager in confidence as the school may be able to access alternative sources of finance.

You will also be asked to give consent and by ticking this box you will be confirming you are aware of the nature of the activity, the information provided in this letter and that you are happy for your child to attend.
