

Y10 Textile Design Parental Contribution

Dear Parent

Your son/daughter has opted for GCSE Textile Design. During Y10 they will be involved in a number of practical workshops to help develop skills. These consist of drawing and painting, dyeing, printing, fabric manipulation, fashion illustration and making a final outcome. All of this work will form Unit 1 entitled Portfolio. This unit is worth 60% of their final grade and will help build skills and knowledge needed to be successful in Y11.

Students will need a basic pack of equipment which will include an **A2 Portfolio** (for carrying study sheets to and from school), an **A3 sketchbook** (to be used for homework), a set of **water colours** and a **brush**, a **2B and 4B pencil** for drawing, a **fineliner** and **half a metre** of cotton fabric. The cost of this pack and other materials your child will use during the workshops is £10. This will allow us to offer a range of exciting practical projects.
