

## Pastoral Care at King Ecgbert School

During their time at King Ecgbert School, every student is looked after by one of our dedicated year managers. The year managers are involved in every part of school life including academic monitoring, well-being, safeguarding, emotional attendance and behaviour, attitude to learning and all the other little things that make up the school day. The year manager liaises with teaching and support staff and, where necessary, with other agencies to support students during their time at school. Year managers work closely with other key members of support staff including our SENCO, Safeguarding and Inclusion Manager, Attendance Officer and Integrated Resource Co-Ordinator.

Our Year 7 Year Manager and transition Co-Ordinator, Miss Machin, will talk with primary schools to get to know all our new students during transition and will support them through their first year here.

During the Y7 induction process, she will be there to answer any questions you may have and support the children with the transition to secondary school.



At the beginning of Y8, the year group is handed over to a new year manager who will support the year group until the end of Y11.

This gives them the opportunity to get to know the students and families well, so that we can work together to provide care and support.

The Year Managers are here to ensure our students feel safe and happy in school and are able to access their learning and every other aspect of school life.
