Quality First Teaching is the most important and effective way to meet the learning needs of students with SEND and our SEN support is designed to ensure that students are able to access the learning in all their lessons. Our teachers are the experts in their subjects and in how students learn, and support is in place to make sure that barriers to learning and that expertise are removed.

We have students with a range of additional needs in school including:

- moderate learning difficulties
- Autism
- specific learning difficulties
- social, emotional and mental health needs
- Speech, language and communication difficulties
- Sensory impairment

We also have a 20 place Integrated Resource for students with Autism who are given additional, specialist support to enable them to study alongside their mainstream peers.
