

I am worried about completing homework and not being able to ask a teacher for help

Homework can be a big worry for students and parents, but we have a good system in school to help support you.

Firstly, you don't have to write down your homework – at King Egbert we use Edulink where all your teachers type up the homework and attach any documents you may need to do it. You can access Edulink on a computer but there is also an app that you and your parents can download and log into.

If we think you might benefit from a bit more support (and focus) for your homework, we also run a homework club and we will send a letter to your parents inviting you (example below).

At King Egbert School we recognise the need to support students with work they are expected to complete outside of their normal lessons.

We would therefore like to invite your child to attend our Homework Club which will run after school in the library from 3.15pm to 4.15pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

A member of staff will be there to support and help students Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, which will allow students to get additional guidance with homework. On Thursdays the library will be opened and supervised for independent study.
