Dress Code @KES

We do not have a formal dress code or uniforms for students. However we expect our students to be wearing suitable clothing as they would do in the work place, to act as role models and to represent our school and sixth form at all times.

We support students to express their identities through allowing different clothing styles and hair colours. However, there need to be rules to ensure a level of professionalism and to ensure the health and safety of students.

The sixth form student council have agreed to the following rules:



- Lanyards must be worn at all times to identify students
- Shoes must be suitable and not pose any health and safety issues
- Hair should be tied back for sporting activities, jewellery removed
- Hats and hoods must not be worn on corridors or in lessons at any time as this is not professional dress



- Phones and earphones must not be used on corridors.
 Wired headphones may be on show, earbuds must be removed
- Puffy/outdoor coats must not be worn on corridors or in lessons at any time as this is not professional dress
- Bare midriffs, short skirts/shorts, low slung trousers, low cut tops or underwear on show as this is not professional dress
- Clothes with slogans which others might find offensive are not permitted

All staff have the right in school to challenge students if this dress code is not adhered to. If students do not obey these rules, they will be verbally warned and if repeatedly fail to follow these rules will be sent home and families informed.
