Dear Parents and Carers

School re-opening in Sheffield delayed until the 15 June at the earliest

Just before the half term break I wrote to you to say we were planning to open King Ecgbert School to Years 10 and 12 from Tuesday 8 June at the earliest.

On Friday 29 May all schools were asked by Greg Fell, the Director of Public Health in Sheffield, to delay all wider school re-opening until Monday 15 June at the earliest. This was to give more time for the NHS 'test and trace' strategy to satisfactorily embed. His reasoning is explained in the attached letter from Cllr Abtisaam Mohammed.

As you would expect we will be following his advice, alongside other schools in the city, and will not be opening school more widely for students until Monday 15 June at the earliest.

Our wider school re-opening plans are well-developed and I will write to you soon about them, and also to confirm the exact start date.
