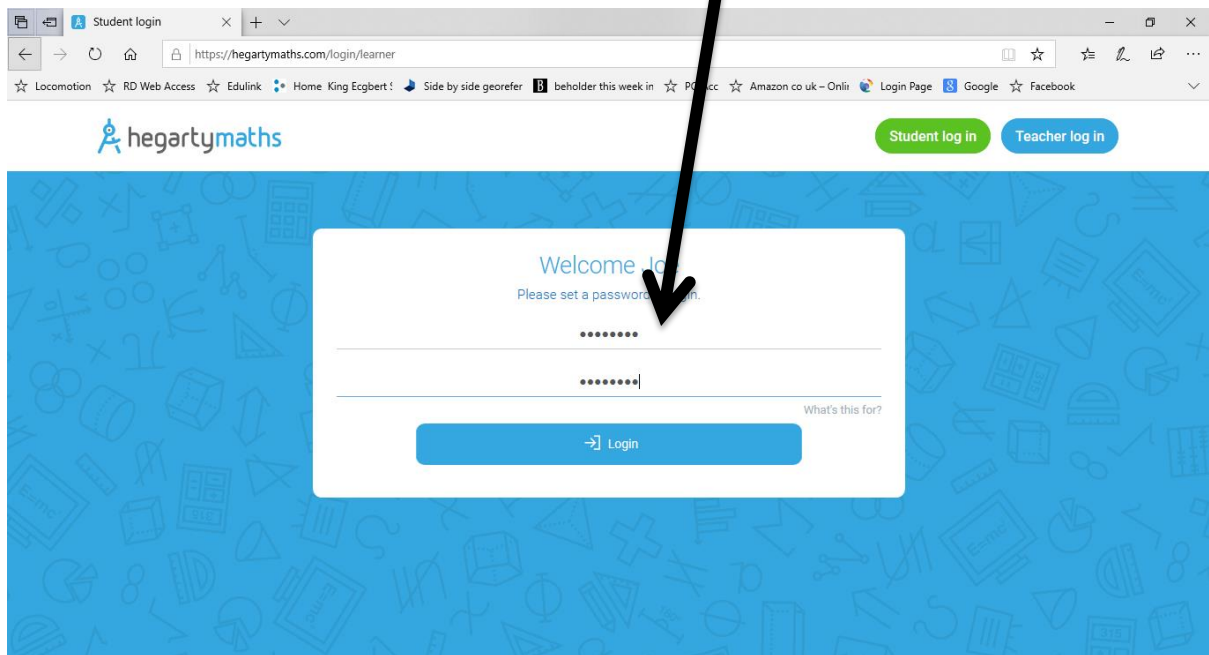
Click on the schools name



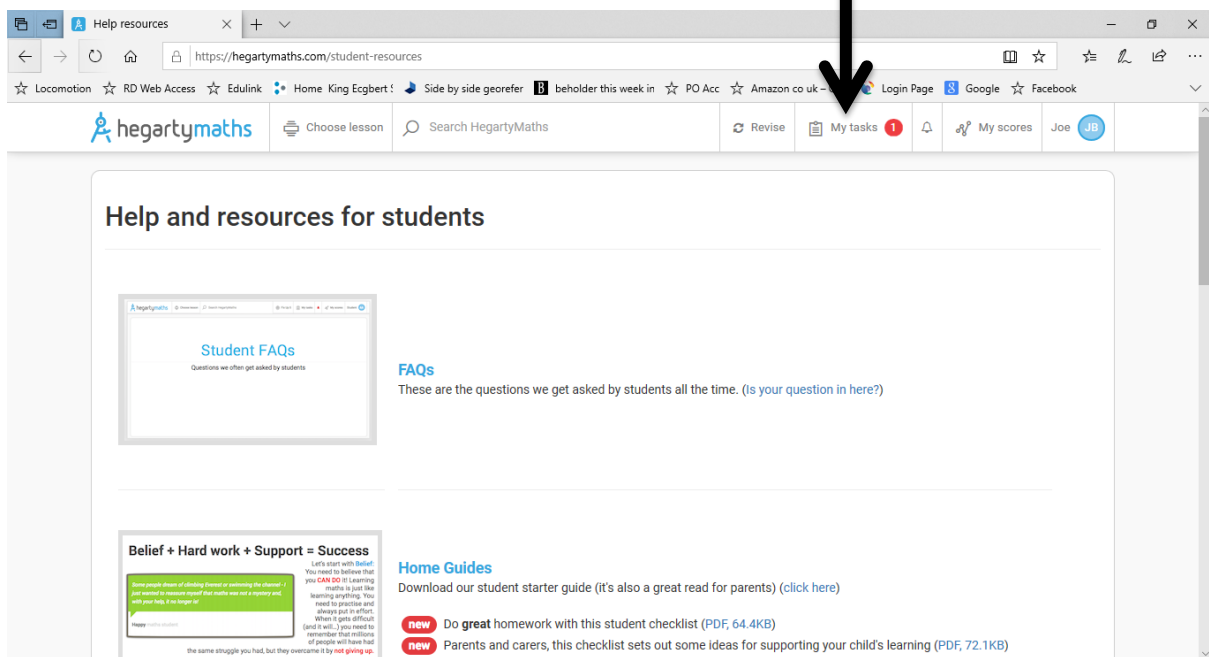
Type in your name, and your date of birth



Then choose a password – make it something memorable

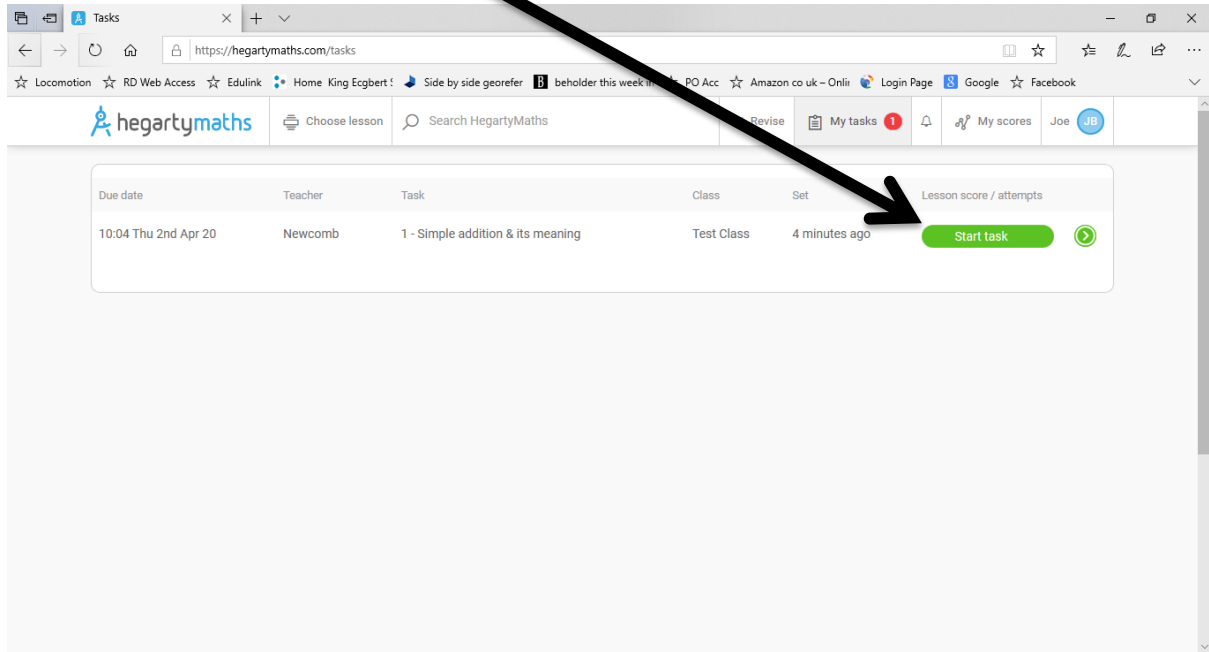


Once you are logged in you will have tasks set for you by your teacher

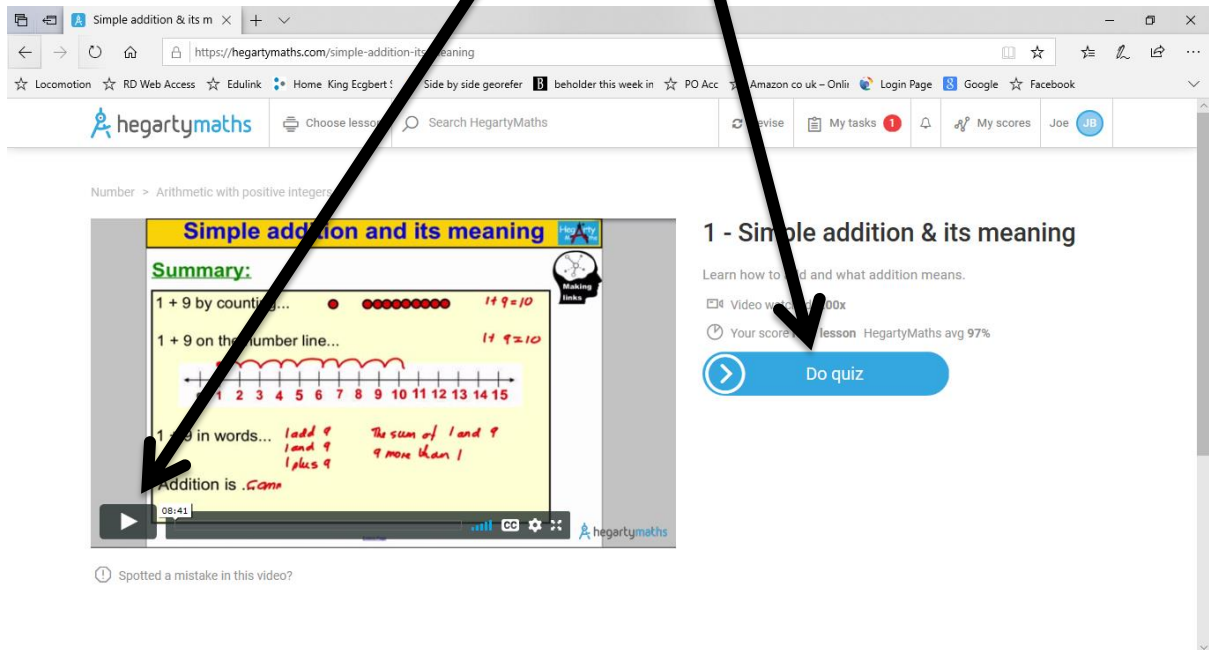


When you click on 'My tasks' you will see the tasks set for you
