We have received your application and are delighted to offer you a place here at King Egbert School Sixth Form from September 2021. This is subject to you fulfilling our entry criteria for each subject.

Induction

In line with government roadmap on changing covid measures by the end of June, we are planning on running a face to face induction on Monday 5 July and Tuesday 6 July. This is an opportunity to meet your form tutor, have a taster lesson in each of your subjects.
